Manager Report:

a) Legislative update: A new state statute took effect January 1st, 2023 with an emphasis on Wyoming Districts meeting the requirements of the Department of Audit. The requirements have always been in place. Now, if non-compliant funding will be withheld or disqualified. This is something that has been in place also. The second part of the statute, that hasn't been in place is that public officers and parties responsible for the accounts as well as the governing body that has oversight of that person are required to complete training within one year. The Department of Audit is working to create such training that will be available thru them; also, Wyoming Special Districts does have training available that has been approved by the Department of Audit. This training must be completed within one year.
